

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 8

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE 2015 CALENDAR YEAR FOR THE SOUTH DURANGO SANITATION DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the South Durango Sanitation District (the "District") is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado organized pursuant to the Colorado Special District Act, C.R.S. 32-1-101, *et seq.* (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the District has previously adopted resolutions establishing rules, regulations and fees for the District; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the Board to change rates, fees and charges periodically; and

WHEREAS, at least 30 days prior the adoption of this resolution notice was posted on the Colorado Special District Association website of the Board's intent to adopt changes for rates, fees and charges for the District

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed its capital reserve fund, debt service requirements and operating budget and has determined that no increase in plant investment and user fees is necessary at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that fees for account transfers and inspections should be increased; and

WHEREAS, the rates, fees and charges adopted by this resolution are appropriate and necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SOUTH DURANGO SANITATION DISTRICT:

1. That effective January 1, 2015, the following schedule of fees shall be adopted:

a. PLANT INVESTMENT FEE:

(i) Single family residential including townhomes, condominiums and mobile homes: \$5,500/ERT;

(ii) Multi-family residential (apartments) and single family residential of 700 square feet or less: \$5,000/ERT;

(iii) Commercial uses: \$5,500/ERT based on attached current commercial ERT schedule or projected flows based on engineering analysis or historical data;

b. MONTHLY USER FEE: \$40.00 per ERT;

c. TAP INSPECTION FEE: \$100 per tap; \$50 per hour for reinspections and inspections of > one hour;

d. TRANSFER FEE: \$25.00 for change of name on account.

2. One (1) ERT shall be based on sewage flows of 180 gallons per day with a five day average BOD⁵ of 250 ppm and 250 ppm total suspended solids.

3. All sections of any prior resolutions establishing fees contrary to those set forth herein are hereby repealed, but only to the extent necessary to conform to the fees established herein.
